### **This is the Environmental Policy Statement of Omicron Research Limited 12<sup>th</sup> May 2021**

Omicron Research Limited is a specialist scientific equipment distributor. Our principal activities include the sales, service and support of tablet dissolution testing systems, thin layer chromatography equipment and other analytical instrumentation. Omicron and its employees are committed to running the business in such a way that will, as far as possible, prevent pollution and support environmental protection.

Omicron recognises the importance of environmental protection and will comply with all environmental legislation, regulations and appropriate codes of practice relating to the processes and activities of the company.
